

UPDATE 2-25-2009 WINDOW of CHINA QUOTED The Chinese Ministry of Education said they would open a new satellite channel **March 1, 2009**. It would **“Train students, teachers and migrant workers.”**

This new use, has updated a more **advanced-use installation**, than that of the **Philippines**, (as discussed previously herein). This new satellite system, has significantly improved the aims/claims, over that, of the **Filipino** usage!

A temporary **“Air Classroom”** was initiated in May 2003, when millions of primary and middle school students had to stay at home because of the severe respiratory syndrome epidemic.”

“In May 2008, the channel was again put into use for students in areas hit by the massive earthquake in southwest China “

The Ministry of Education, the CETV’s sponsor, announced Wednesday that the **“Air Classroom”** channel will broadcast **four hours of on-campus extra-curricular activities, 6.5 hours of high-quality lessons by well-known teachers, and another four hours of teachers’ training programs.”**

The new channel would be responsible for providing distance training programs for **350,000 teachers in 100 counties in the under-developed central and western areas during the summer vacation.**

The timetable of the channel is scheduled in accord with that of schools to enable students and teachers to watch, Chen (Chen Li) said. Chen Li is the editor of CHINA EDUCATION TELEVISION [CETV].”

NOTE: The article did **NOT** make clear, if the broadcast **hours/data** are **daily, weekly** or **monthly**. It also does **NOT** seem to indicate, that such lessons are capable of 2-way communication.
