According to The Star Ledger, the **Passaic County** Prosecutor's Office receives another grant announced **3-28-2008**, of **\$ 268,000.00**. This is the **3rd** one, from the Federal Government (**Dep't of Homeland Security**), to speed up installation of the fiber-optic communication network.

Summing up the amounts of money, (**1-13-06 \$1, 900,000.00** Page **28**), plus [**\$ 270,000.00** on **2-13-06 P 30**]. The total money rec'd to date, totals **\$ 2,438,000.00**.

Remember, this is to tie together, all police departments in Passaic County, **New Jersey**, for the instantaneous sharing of law enforcement activities. This is the same kind of promise, as was made in **1978**, to the **Dominican Republic** .

In that case, the promise was, to tie **ALL** schools together in the **whole country**. This was of special importance to **far-flung** areas of the country. The **Paterson** School system installation, included the police station, for additional **24 hr.** security reasons, also!

NOTE: A like-promise, was made by **President Arroyo** of the **Philippines**, **Aug. 19, 2007**, [**P 118**], in a **500 Million Dollar** network, to be installed by a **Chinese** Company (with the assistance of the **Chinese** Government). That installation was for a rudimentary, **TTEC-like** Educational network, as discussed in the **TTEC** Book.
